RELATIVE TO DECLARING JULY 22, 2022, A SPECIAL HOLIDAY FOR THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM Supreme Court of Guam
Administrative Order No. ADM22-004_____

WHEREAS, in Executive Order No. 2022-19 dated July 6, 2022, *I Maga'håga* declared a special holiday closing all executive branch departments and agencies of the Government of Guam on Friday, July 22, 2022 to celebrate Liberation Day; and

WHEREAS, to provide uniformity and equity throughout the Government of Guam and in recognition of the loyalty and dedication of the employees of the Judiciary of Guam in maintaining a responsive and reliable Judiciary for the people of Guam, it is reasonable to likewise close the Judicial Branch and allow Judiciary of Guam employees to enjoy the Liberation Day holiday.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, I do **ORDER** that the Judicial Branch of the government of Guam shall be closed and its employees excused from duty on Friday, July 22, 2022, except for magistrate hearings, or any other emergency filings. Any filing due on that day shall be deemed timely filed if filed on Monday, July 25, 2022.
