- Artwork must be submitted on an 11" x 17" paper and must be the student's original work
- Artwork can be drawn and/or colored with any art supplies (paint, watercolor, crayons, markers, etc.)
- Artwork will not be returned
- Artwork will be judged according to its originality, creativity, and how well the artwork represents the theme

Please include the student's name and grade, teacher's name and school name on the back of the artwork.

- Law Day certificate; and
