MEMORANDUM:

Subject: Amendment No. 2
Re: IFB 23-09; X-Ray Scanner & Walk Through Metal Detector

Below are responses to questions submitted to my office:

1. Kindly clarify the vibration shock absorbers.

Response: The wheels on the x-ray scanner shall be shock-absorbing wheels which will reduce the shock and vibration transferred to the x-ray scanner.

2. We use either an internal AVR or UPS protection for the computer component of the x-ray. Is the required UPS an internal component or to be used for the whole x-ray machine?

Response: The UPS requirement is for the protection of the entire x-ray machine, computer and its components. The end goal is for the protection of the entire machine. What ever can provide the best protection from power outages and glitches.

3. What is the required back-up time for the UPS?

Response: 30-45 min. back-up time for the UPS is required.

4. Clarification with the mobile heavy-duty rollers. Are these heavy-duty roller caster for the x-ray? Or are these the roller tables attached to the x-ray scanner machine at the entry or exit tunnel? Usually, the rollers (and x-ray conveyor) are capable of handling bags and packages going through the x-ray which can take up to 165kg of evenly distributed load.

Response: The heavy-duty roller casters are for the x-ray machine. The entry and exit tables must be either off the ground and/or have collapsible roller tables to allow for easy relocation.

5. As for the NIJ Compliance, can we consider NIJ-0601.02 and/or NIJ-0601.03?

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Response: To remain compliant with the NIJ walk through metal detector standards the Judiciary will require that the proposed equipment must meet the current required NIJ standards.
