Subject: **Amendment No. 6**
Re: RFP 25-02; VOIP Telephone Services

Below are responses to questions submitted to my office:

1. Please clarify if Judiciary of Guam is now requiring a primary and a secondary diverse path into all Judiciary of Guam buildings? This was not required on the original state of work.

Response: No. We do not require a secondary diverse path; however, we are requiring that the primary path is hardened enough to withstand some or all natural and man-made disasters.

2. Kindly requesting for an extension unit clarification is made.
Referencing: Response on Amendment 4: Regarding the question on the definition of "protected", this refers to a secondary link to route our phone lines should the main line to our building be damaged.

Response: As stated on our response to question #1, we do not require a secondary diverse path, or secondary link to route the phone lines, however, we require that the primary link is hardened enough to withstand some or all natural and man-made disasters.

3. Given that most carriers are abandoning copper-based facilities and moving to fiber, will Judiciary consider analog conversions of VoIP?

Response: If the service provided, supports our current equipment, such as, JOG elevator, security alarms, and fax lines then the conversion is not an issue.
